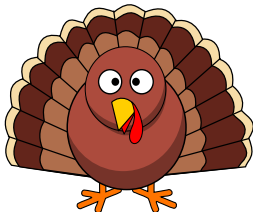

Strategies for supporting the development of counting in young children

1. Count everything and anything—make it part of your daily routines.
2. Use your fingers to show numbers and to point.
3. Ask your child, “How many?”
4. Use number words (i.e. can you bring me 2 socks?)
5. First this, second that—use “first....and then” directions with your child.
6. Read number books. Looking for a good one? Read *Chicka Chicka 1,2,3* by Bill Martin or *10 Black Dots* by Donald Crews
7. Engage in other mathematical concepts using numbers. Children can use numbers to compare quantities, measure, and estimate amounts.
8. Play games—board games such as “Chutes and Ladders” and other types of toys like blocks can be used to practice and encourage counting.
9. Name it, show it, touch it, say it, move it! (Say the number, show the number with your fingers, point at the object, say the number again, and then move the object a small distance away.)
