

Mission Spending Plan Update



By the Numbers...

114% General Giving to Budget

Actual = \$1,028,971 This number is the amount given by the congregation from July 2023 through March 2024.

Budget = \$903,652 This number is the amount of giving to the General Fund the congregation committed for July 2023 through March 2024. The General Fund supports 90% of the ministry needs of the congregation.

114% Total Actual Income to Budget = \$1,112,821

The number includes the General Fund <u>and</u> other revenues (duplex rental income, directed giving, Seeds of Faith reimbursements, and other receipts). Other revenues beyond the General Fund typically supports 10% of the annual needs of the congregation.

Expenses to Budget

Actual = \$883,535 Expenses are less than budgeted, mainly due to vacant staff positions.

Budgeted = \$968,342 The congregation committed to spend this amount on the ministries provided at Faith Lutheran Church from July 2023 through March 2024.

Restricted & Reserve Funds = \$602,935

Restricted funds at the end of December stand at \$220,758. These include specific areas of ministry that donors have supported over several years such as organ maintenance, the Kifula Tanzania Companionship, Memorial Fund, etc. This reserve fund stands at \$382,177.

What Does This Mean?

This means we **celebrate** the wonderful generosity of the congregation! Faith has not seen the level of giving for well 8 years. This is due to members and active participants taking seriously their spiritual practice of giving financially to God's mission in and through this congregation. **Thank you!**
